22 June 1920 – 14 January 1945

(aged 24)



Lieutenant Wayne C. Wingo, bomber pilot in combat training in New Guinea, has been missing since January 14 over New Guinea, the War Department notified his wife, Mrs. Betty Wingo, 774 McConnell.

He is the son of W. C. Wingo, 1931 Lamar, and Mrs. Nora Wingo, 124 N. Cleveland.

A graduate of Tech he was with the Edison Company when he entered the AAF in February 1943. He won his wings at Columbus MS in March 1944.
